



Moderator's Assignment Feedback – Transfer up to High Court

After each series, we ask our moderators to provide a report on each assignment-based unit to identify

- any questions which were usually answered particularly well, including main points and qualities that characterised good answers.
- any questions which were usually answered badly and main weaknesses in candidates' answers.
- common errors or misconceptions made by candidates.

We hope that this will be of assistance when completing your Debt Collection Operations Management assignment.

General feedback to candidates

Overall, candidates' performance in this session was acceptable. Two-thirds of candidates achieved a Level 4 Pass. Candidates showed a reasonable knowledge of the process, and needed to show they understood how to this process applies in actual cases to achieve a higher grade.

Feedback for each assignment question

Q1. Explain how to transfer up in each of the following cases:

a) Transferring up a County Court judgment to the High Court in order to issue a Writ of Control

Q1a – Most candidates gave a reasonable outline of the process to achieve a Level 4 Pass

b) Transferring up in order to issue a Writ of Possession

Q1b - Again, most answers outlined the process. Candidates need to show awareness of the distinction between how trespasser and non trespasser cases affect the process for transfer

c) Transferring up in order to issue a combined Writ of Possession and Writ of Control

Q1c – Candidates should note that the question wording differs from 1b, asking for a combined Writ

d) Transferring up an Employment Judgment/ACAS COT3¹ Agreement for a Writ of Control to be issued

Q1d - Generally, reasonably answered

e) Transferring up a foreign judgment, in order to issue a Writ of Control

Q1e - Generally, reasonably answered

Q2. Explain how to extend or re-issue a Writ of Control

Q2 - Generally, adequately answered

Q3. Explain how to extend or reissue other Writs of Execution

Q3 - Generally, less well answered than 2 as candidates repeated content from that question
